2. Uniforms – Please wear khaki bottoms (shorts, pants, skorts, etc) with comfortable shoes.
3. Please DO NOT bring valuables as we are not responsible if left unattended.
4. Check the weather and come prepared. (sunscreen, rain jackets, chairs, snacks if needed).

5. Parking will be located on the resort property in the Inverness lot. Enter through the main gate and tell the security guard you are a tournament volunteer. You will be given a pass and directed to the Inverness lot. SuperShuttle will drive you to the clubhouse.

Saturday – 6:30 a.m. to one hour after play is concluded.
